School Transport

Free for all students.

School Card

Used for access to services, meals, and stationery. It is cashless – the card must be preloaded. – SIGA Platform.

O INOVAR Consulta

The INOVAR Consulta platform provides school activity information.

Inovar Consulta is a portal where information about each student's school activity can be consulted, using any type of computer device with an Internet connection.

Student Access

- Login: Student process number (found on student card ask your class teacher if needed)
- Password: Student's ID number (Citizen Card or document on file)

Parent/Guardian Access

- Login: Email address of the guardian
- Password: Sent to their email

If you forgot your password, click "Forgot password" on the login page, then follow the email instructions. If no email is received, contact Administrative Services (Tel: 231 458 512) to check if your email is correctly registered.

SIGA Portal

Used to book meals, check school purchases, and top up the school card.

Guardians receive access instructions from the Mira Town Hall after enrollment. If not, request the document at the Administrative Services.

Moodle Portal

Used by students and teachers as a complement to in-person classes. Provides access to subjects, content, and assignments. Also allows messaging between students and teachers.

To access:

- Go to: http://acesso.escolasdemira.pt/moodle
- Click the Google button and log in with your school email credentials;
- In case the login is not successful use: login a1234 (1234 should be replaced by your student card number) and the password provided by the teachers

Moodle APP

We recommend installing the Moodle app on any device (smartphone, tablet, PC). It provides assignment notifications and schedule updates.

- Username: a1234 (1234 should be replaced by your student card number)
- Password: provided by the Class Director or ICT teacher

School Life

- **Classroom:** Only teachers open and close classrooms.
- Mobile devices may be used for educational purposes in the secondary school but are prohibited in other schools of the cluster.
- Students and teachers must take care of materials and equipment.

Textbooks

- Free but must be returned in good condition at the end of the school year.
- Register on the Mega Textbook Platform to receive vouchers.
